### Gospel

Amid the constant bombardment of advertising that promotes convenience foods, there are also plenty of warnings about the dangers they post to our health. To pay attention to these is to discover that much of the processed food that we eat has little nutritional value. Worse still, it is usually riddle with ingredients that are quite detrimental to our health. Is there a parallel with the food we feed to our minds? Do we think twice about whether its nourishing or just junk? Does what we read and talk about feed our hearts with wisdom and truth and love, or does it go to maintain our anxieties and reinforce our negative attitudes? This is the question raised for us by Jesus's exchange with the crowd after they had been feed. On what do we feed? What do we truly hunger and thirst for, and what steps do we take to nurture our inmost selves? Today's word of God offers us the opportunity to look again.
