In this age of spin doctors and carefully worded media releases, it is refreshing to turn to the scripture and discover a wealth of unvarnished truth. Do you ever feel discouraged? 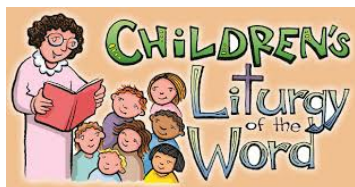
