This Weeks Gospel

Jesus tells us: "You are the salt of the earth." What does it mean to be salt? Think about what salt does. It adds flavour to foods that lack sufficient taste. Jesus also raises the point that if we lose our flavour, how can it be restored? The answer is: Only by letting God renew us.

In your baptism, you were made flavourful – alive with God's love, peace, joy, etc. Fruitful Christians are those who evangelize by adding the seasoning of God's life – God's love, peace, joy, etc. – to the lives of the people around them.

But beware of trying too hard! What happens when food is over-salted? It tastes horrible. No matter how good our intentions might be, if we come on too strong, we do more harm than good. People are much more likely to turn to Jesus if they first experience his love from us, and his peace in how we treat them. joys.
