### The Twin Parishes of Ss Peter & Paul, Doncaster East, and Our Lady Of The Pines, Donvale, will jointly run a set of Mental Health First Aid courses.

We have a grant that gives us funding to run a Free Mental Health First Aid Training for up to ONE HUNDRED Residents of Manningham to learn practical skills to support someone with a Mental health problem. The course is a self-paced eLearning component of about 5 - 7 hours online, followed by 2 sessions of about 2.5 hours each using Zoom video conferencing. Participants who attend all sessions in full will have the opportunity to sit an optional, short, online, open book test. 

**Archbishops message this week.**

We are coming towards the Sunday where there will be announcements made about the next level of easing up of restrictions as we come out of COVID. Please God they are effective things. But here's where I want to invite you to be active—over this coming week—to be active in speaking up to ask that our places of worship here, for instance in St Patrick's where I am at the moment, might be able to be opened up in an equivalent way to other sectors in our society. At the moment we have some disparity going on — so you can gather outdoors in a pub in regional Victoria up to 50 people, but you can only gather for 10 outdoors for a faith gathering. We need parity in this sort of thing. So I'd encourage you to speak up this week, maybe with the parliamentarians, maybe on talk-back radio or some way in which you can encourage parity — not asking for anything special — just consistency in and parity across the various sectors.
