Contact tracing and prebooking for masses.

From this weekend onwards we will be utilizing the 1Breadcrumb app for our contact tracing purposes. There is a booklet in the Foyer with full details of how to install the app.

With this system the requirement for pre booking is no longer required. We do however still need to comply with the seating capacity in the Church which is 120 in total. We regret that once we reach capacity , we can't allow anyone further in.

Please note: following changes on the 31/12/20 ,the use of face coverings is now required within an indoor setting unless you have a lawful reason not to.

In two distinct ways the baptism of the Lord serves as a bridge. Firstly, it doubles up as the concluding feast of the Christmas season and the First Sunday of Ordinary Time. Secondly, and much more significantly it highlights a dramatic transition in Jesus life. All three synoptic gospels identify Jesus' Baptism as the event which plucks him out of obscurity and impels him into public ministry. More's the pity that this feast like that of the Holy Family and of the Epiphany occurs during the Australian summer holiday season. Not one of the Gospel stories from these festivals is ever read on another Sunday, except on the rare occasion when the feast of the Presentation of the Lord falls on a Sunday. The Gospel account of Jesus' baptism are brief and rich in meaning. They reveal him as God's beloved son and envoy: they provoke us to a fresh awareness of the mission to which we are called as the baptised. In the preface for the feast, we praise God for our coming "to believe in your Word
