New Contact Tracing Requirements effective from the 1st of May 2021.

On Friday 26 March, Victoria moved to a more relaxed COVIDSafe setting. As part of these changes, electronic record keeping became mandatory for all venues and facilities, including our Places of Worship.

Importantly, from 26 March, activities involving ceremonies and religious gatherings, weddings and funerals within a Place of Worship, must use an electronic record keeping system that is compatible with the Victorian Government's visitation application programming interface (API).

The API allows non-Government electronic record keeping systems to 'speak' with the Victorian Department of Health (DH) contact tracing system, which is the primary line of defence in keeping our community safe and open.

The previous rule was that electronic record keeping was required for a Place of Worship when applying the one person per 1.5 metres density quotient. This density quotient still applies and API compatible electronic record keeping is now mandatory.

In view of this, the need to register your attendance either by use of the 1Breadcrumb App or by using the QR code in the Parish is paramount in us being able to maintained a 1.5 metre rule. We ask that all Parishioners please assist us in maintaining a responsible reporting method by using the QR code in the Parish on your 1 Breadcrumb App or by using the 1 breadcrumb app and adjusting your settings to allow for location services.

If you do not have a mobile phone , please either ask the Covid Captain to assist you or a friend at church who has a mobile phone to log in for you.

If any parishioner has a spare Ipad or mobile phone that is no longer used , could we ask if you would consider lending/giving this to the Parish in order to assist us in helping parishioners who do not have a mobile phone to log in . Thank you all very much for your assistance with this .
