Ss Peter & Paul's One in a Hundred Appeal – Launching for 2021-22

Dear friends, Coming to the end of the first month of our 2021-22 Appeal we are pleased to advise that contributions of \$6,428 have been received since 1st July, and to thank each of our 37 magnificent contributors for their generosity.

This is an amazing response considering these pandemic times, and a powerful recognition of the circumstances being faced by Sr Trudy and the Notre Dame De Sion Local Children's Fund in Jerusalem. While all our efforts have been directed to assistance with the children's education, it is in the context of the struggles the Palestinians are having with the coronavirus that there are further concerns.

Our objective for the Appeal has been to raise \$10,000 annually, but it seems inappropriate to settle on a particular amount, the suggestion being to just raise what we can, to be available to assist with the children's education as first priority, but then to extend to whatever needs are being faced today.

With our first transfer to be made at the end of August, we would ask all intending contributors to bring their contributions forward if they can, to enable us to send the largest amount possible. The Appeal will continue throughout 2021-22 to meet continuing needs and take up ongoing support from all our contributors – annual, six monthly and monthly.
