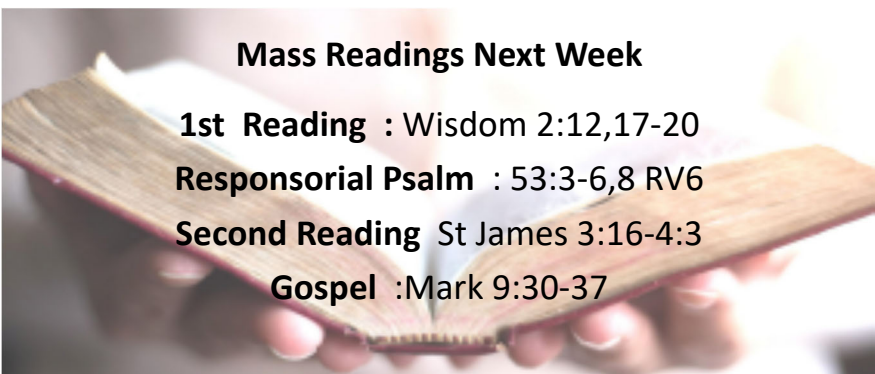

Recent Death

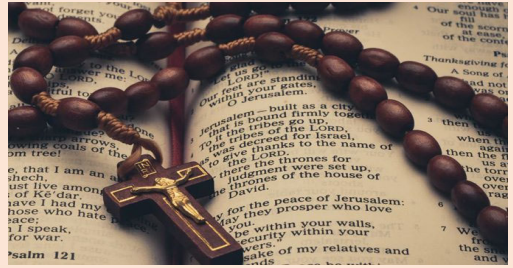
We are sorry to advise that John Dodd who moved to Wangaratta a number of years ago went home to God this week . John was an active member before his move.
