However Fr Jerald's main priority is for the health and safety of all our parishioners . Please don't feel the need to rush back this weekend if you are at all uncomfortable as we will still be offering Zoom Masses for the next few weeks.

**NEW ARRANGEMENTS.** From 6.00pm Friday the 29th of October, in line with Victorian Government regulations, the arrangements for Masses at SSPP will be as follows.

**Weekday Masses (Tue, Thu and Sat 9.00am)** Up to 30 people may attend, Vaccinations is not required. Bookings are not required.

**Weekend Masses (Sat 6.00pm and Sunday 8.00am and 11.5am)** Up to 120 people may attend . All attendees aged 16+ must be fully vaccinated. Bookings are not required. Please arrive early to allow time to check-in and show your Vaccination Certificate to the Covid Marshall.

**5pm Sunday Mass at Ss Peter and Paul's Church for those not fully vaccinated.**

If you have had only one dose of the vaccine or prefer to remain unvaccinated , there will be an extra Mass each Sunday at 5.00pm at Ss Peter and Paul's Church for both SSPP and OLOP parishioners only. 30 people are permitted . Bookings are essential through Trybooking . Bookings will close at 5.00pm on the Saturday prior. The Trybooking link is <https://www.trybooking.com/BVDHV>

**All Souls day mass at SSPP:** Tuesday the 2nd of November at 9.00am. This mass will be held on Zoom however you may attend in person if you don't have access to Zoom. Up to 30 people may attend. Vaccination is not required. The in person Mass is for parishioners of OLOP and SSPP only. Booking is essential and will close at 12 noon on Monday the 1st of November.
