### Resumption of Masses

Resumption of Masses Fr Jerald has enjoyed seeing some of you in person at Mass again over the past few days. With the further easing of restrictions even more of you will have the opportunity to attend in person if you wish. However Fr Jerald's main priority is for the health and safety of all our parishioners. Please don't feel the need to rush back this weekend if you are at all uncomfortable as we will still be offering Zoom Masses for the next few weeks.

**NEW ARRANGEMENTS.** From 6.00pm Friday the 29th of October, in line with Victorian Government regulations, the arrangements for Masses at SSPP will be as follows.

**Weekday Masses (Tue and Thu 9.00am)** Up to 30 people may attend, Vaccinations is not required. Bookings are not required.

**Communion Service ( Mon, Wed and Friday)** will resume from Monday the 8th of November 2021.

**Weekend Masses (Sat 5.00pm and Sunday 9.30am)** Up to 120 people may attend. All attendees aged 16+ must be fully vaccinated. Bookings are not required. Please arrive early to allow time to check-in and show your Vaccination Certificate to the Covid Marshall.

**Weekend Zoom Mass :** With effect from the 13th of November, Zoom weekend mass will now only be held on Sundays at 9.30am.

**5pm Sunday Mass at Ss Peter and Paul's Church for those not fully vaccinated.**

If you have had only one dose of the vaccine or prefer to remain unvaccinated, there will be an extra Mass each Sunday at 5.00pm at Ss Peter and Paul's Church for both SSPP and OLOP parishioners only. 30 people are permitted.
