SsPP "ONE IN A HUNDRED APPEAL" 20 YEARS ON

From a project that commenced in 2003 with funds raised of \$A600, early this year we transferred \$A13,000 contributed from July 2021 to early 2022 to Sr Trudy, to support the Notre Dame De Sion Local Children's Education Fund (Jerusalem), and the Palestinian families and their children who benefit.

This has been a magnificent effort under the shadow of the Covid pandemic, and is testament to your outstanding generosity in difficult times. Thank you from Sr Trudy and the Sion Sisters in Jerusalem , and from myself as the co-ordinator.

Because it has been necessary, funds have been taken from the Education Fund to assist with living expenses as well, and the Fund has suffered. Overall contributions have reduced, so much so that SsPP is now the largest donor.
