SsPP "One in a Hundred Appeal" Sr Trudy's Visit on Sunday 9th October

This is especially for those unable to be present at the 8.00am Mass on the 9th or to access the record of what was said on the "youtube", or indeed anyone.

Sr Trudy referred to her 26 years in Jerusalem as a Sister of Our Lady of Sion in the community of Ecce Homo, and how the Notre Dame de Sion Local Children's Education Fund starting in 2000 was the response to the 2nd Intifada during the 1980's and 1990's when a generation of children didn't go to school.

SsPP took up the cause, with our One in a Hundred Appeal starting in 2003, and has generously given its support from the start. In the early years it provided financial assistance for one hundred or more primary and secondary students annually, but the current position is that the numbers are down to fifty children from around twenty families.

SsPP Appeal is now the only source of funding except for reserves accumulated by the Sisters in good times, and that is why the numbers are down and future prospects are poor. The current assessment is that provided SsPP supports the Sion Sisters by maintaining its donor position, the Education Fund will keep going until around September 2024.

Education is where Palestinians and Israelis meet, cut down prejudice and work to establish the road to peace, and this is likely more valuable than just the dollars.

Live-Stream of Sat 6pm Mass


