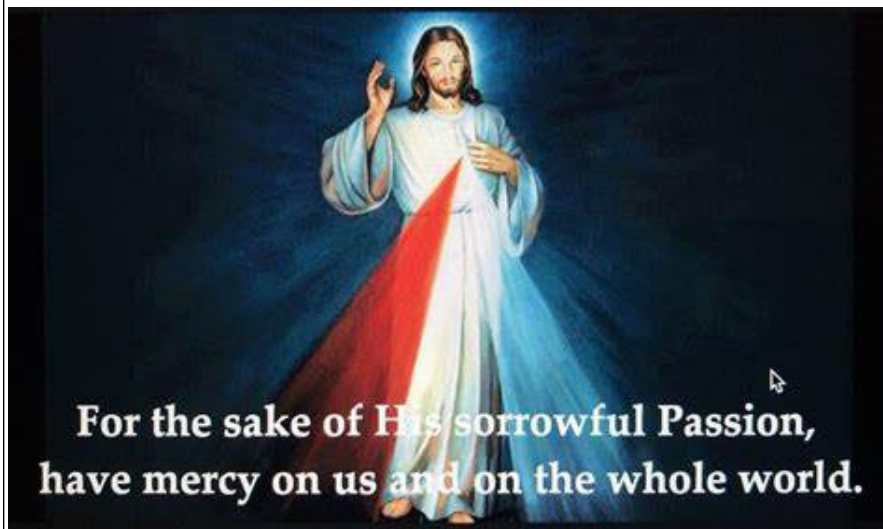
Black Missal Found
