The Most Holy Trinity is a central mystery of Christian faith and life, celebrating the belief that God is One God in Three Divine Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit<sup>12345</sup>. The doctrine of the Trinity means that there is one God who eternally exists as three distinct Persons. The Father begets the Son and loves him, and the Son loves the Father in return. This love is so powerful that it breathes forth another Divine Person: the Holy Spirit<sup>1</sup>. The human mind can never fully understand the mystery of the Trinity, but it is the most fundamental and essential teaching in the hierarchy of the truths of faith.




