Carmelitae Sancti Eliae (CSE), Daughters of Carmel and Holy Trinity Community.

Established in 1982 by Fr. Yohanes Indrakusuma in Malang, Indonesia, the Daughters of Carmel (sisters) represent the first order, followed by the Carmelitae Sancti Eliae (brothers and priests) in 1986, and the Holy Trinity Community (laypeople) in 1987. These three orders embrace the core spirituality of the original Carmelite hermits, infused with the Charismatic Renewal.

Renowned for their ministry in spiritual guidance, including retreats and the management of spiritual centers, both CSE and the Daughters of Carmel jointly oversee seven such centers. The largest among them is situated in Cipanas, West Java, just a two-hour drive from Jakarta, the capital of Indonesia. In addition to their spiritual guidance, these organizations are recognized for their healing ministry, regularly drawing as many as 5,000 pilgrims to Healing Masses in Cipanas.

The Holy Trinity Community, with over 13,000 members across ten countries, extends its reach worldwide. In Australia, HTC has firmly established itself in Melbourne and Sydney since the late '90s. It collaborates with CSE and the Daughters of Carmel to host annual retreats and actively engages in ministering within local parishes, operating under the guidance of local bishops.
