You are cordially invited to attend this special Mass.


Masses on the 24th of December

News from Sr Trudy

It was very pleasing to hear from Sr Trudy recently, after the October 7th attack and subsequent events. She was fortunate to be on Order business in Rome at the time and experienced considerable difficulty in getting back to Jerusalem with cancelling and rebooking issues. She sends her love and prayers to you and especially thanks to all at Ss Peter and Paul's for the prayers that came from us.

Trudy describes the Old City of Jerusalem as relatively quiet – shops closed, no pilgrims or tourists, people fearful and staying at home. They are struggling to survive without sufficient income, no government assistance. The ethos of the Sion Order is that they are open to both sides and supportive of groups working together for solutions.

Assistance is needed to enable the Sion Sisters to give as much as they can to those in the greatest need.

Our 2023-24 'One in a Hundred' Appeal has recently met its primary target of \$10,000, so thanks to all who have made this possible. While the purpose for over twenty years of our support has been directed to the Notre Dame de Sion Local Children Education Fund, Sr Trudy needs to assess what is needed to support families at this difficult time, while providing for the education of their children.

Please continue to pray for the Sisters of Our Lady of Sion that they may be a beacon shining in the darkness, and above all that peace can be achieved.
