NAIDOC WEEK

Marking the start of NAIDOC week (7-14 July), the Mass is an opportunity to come together and celebrate Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People. On the first Sunday of July each year, the Catholic Church in Australia observes Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Sunday.

On this day we gather as one to honour and celebrate the rich cultural heritage and contributions of our First Nations Peoples to our Catholic Church. The theme for this year's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Sunday is *"Keep the Fire Burning—Strong in Faith"*.

NEED TO DISPOSE OF A VEHICLE?

Getting a roadworthy, taking photos to advertise on the internet, cleaning and polishing, taking calls (if they come), even finding a garage until a prospective buyer turns up (if indeed they do!).

If you need to dispose of a vehicle from a deceased estate or which is no longer required, could you consider gifting it to the "Lifeboat Foundation", a registered charity with tax deductible status, which for ten years has been providing pastoral and practical support to nearly 150 victims / survivors across Australia of church-related sexual abuse.

Many of these suffer Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), have limited or no employment, and a donated vehicle could vastly improve their quality of life and / or generate funds to assist personal, medical and accommodation needs.

As such, it is crucial for all volunteers, regardless of their specific role, to have a valid and current check. We kindly ask you to review the status of your WWCC and renew it if necessary. 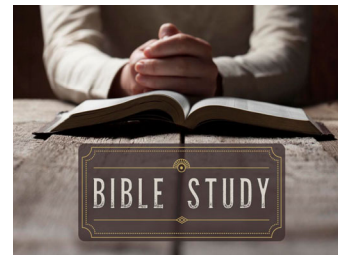
