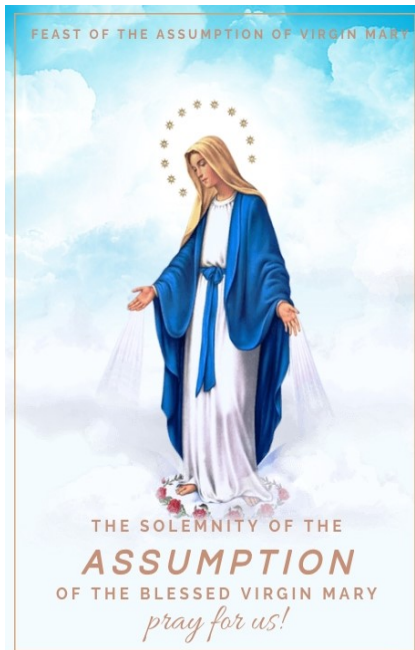

All that we need help with is conducting the class every Sunday during our 11.15am Mass.

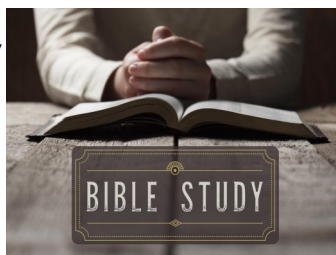
